November 10th, 2011

National protest in Montreal against the tuition hike. The massive student participation represents a historical mobilisation for the student movement. 30,000 protesters

December 6th, 2010

National protest in Quebec City during the Meeting of Education Partners as one the meeting's objective was to legitimate the new tuition hike. approx. 4,000 protesters

March 31st, 2011

National protest in Montreal to denounce the new tuition hike, the amount having been announced a few days earlier. approx. 4,000 protesters

October 21st, 2010

Montreal protest against the Meeting of Education Partners. approx. 500 protesters

March 12th, 2011

Protest under the banner "A Fair Budget: A Question of Choice". approx. 55,000 protesters

March 24th, 2011

Occupation of Finance Minister Raymond Bachand's offices.

September 24th, 2010

Occupation of Education Minister Line Beauchamp's offices.

April 1st, 2010

Montreal protest to denounce antisocial measures following the provincial budget announcement in which the Finance Minister established, amongst other measures, a tuition hike. approx. 12 000 protesters
